## **BE AWARE!** Know your responsibilities!



If you accept free soil, the possibility it contains asbestos, or other contaminants is high. Contaminants on your land will impact your property value. A Council or the Environment Protection Authority may require you to do a clean-up at your cost. Remediation is expensive and time-consuming.

## SOIL TO YOU

- To legally use waste soil, follow **all** requirements of a resource recovery exemption. **Never** take free soil material without checking from where it came.
- Always ask for a loading docket and, record this information as a waste register.
- Always add the truck registration (not the trailer registration) to your waste register when the delivery truck arrives.
- Always record on your waste register, the source of the soil (as street address or GPS coordinates for 2020), otherwise, the transaction **is** invalid.
- The Environment Protection Authority (NSW) resource recovery order must accompany the soil
  material classification/ certification document for the transaction record. Always get the soil
  certification documents for their transaction record; before the soil is tipped from the truck.
- Without paperwork and the project and transport verification, you the property owner **will** become an illegal dumper on your land.
- Never accept a load of dirt without a check of the paperwork! Always use a certified soil practitioner to do this!
- Always use recovered site soil with the intent to minimise, mitigate and eliminate land degradation.

## SOIL FROM YOU

- To legally supply a waste for reuse on land and property around NSW, follow **all** requirements of a Resource Recovery Exemption **and** the corresponding Resource Recovery Order. **Always** provide the receiver with a verifiable transaction the Resource Recovery Order, a waste classification or certification, and the relevant Resource Recovery Exemption. Without **all** three, the transaction is illegal.
- Always supply with the intent to minimise, mitigate and eliminate land degradation.
- Always provide a record of the site of delivery (as street address or GPS coordinates); otherwise, the transaction is invalid. Use a waste register.
